NONDISCRIMINATORY

FRESHMEN

All applicants must complete and document **at least one** of the following requirements to be considered for acceptance:

- Have received a high school diploma from an accredited secondary school, or
- Have passed the California High School Proficiency Exam, or
- Have passed the General Education Development Exam, or
- Have completed high school at a documented home school or individual study program, or
- Be 18 years of age and able to complete or pass one of the previously listed requirements within the first semester of enrollment, or
- Be enrolled in the English as a Second Language Program

TRANSFER STUDENTS

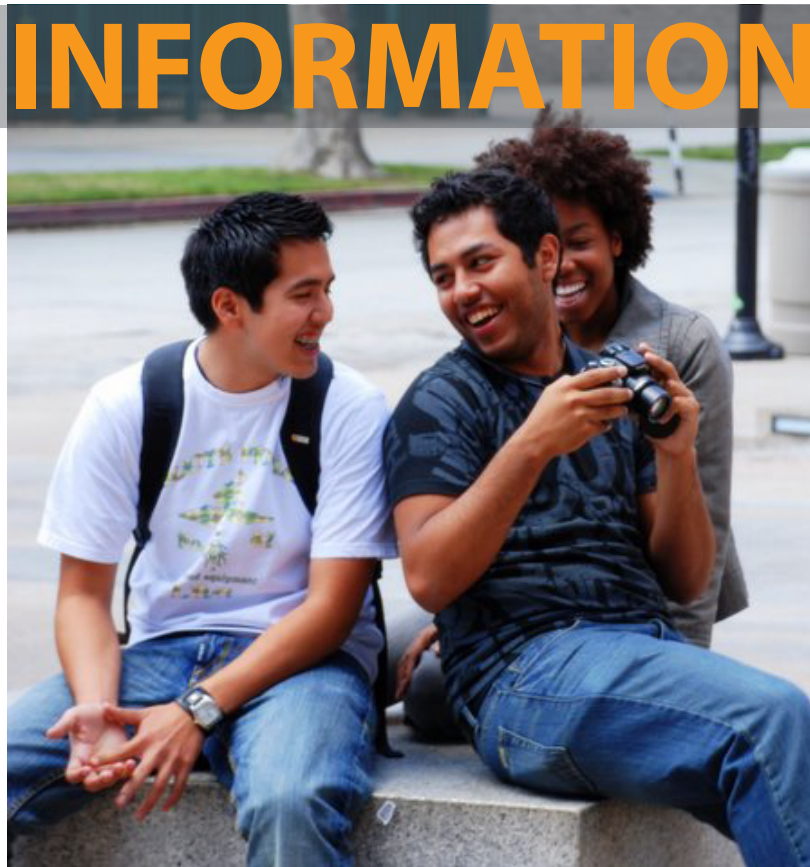
Transfer students may be admitted using the Freshmen requirements listed above, or:

- Have earned 12 or more transferable (non-remedial) units of college credits.

Students who request credit for courses taken at another accredited college must submit an official transcript delivered from the school of origin in a sealed envelope to the Admissions and Records Office at CPC. Transcripts will be evaluated according to the scholastic standards and policies at California Preparatory College.
